How can I help? What can I do?

Elsie Bennett Community Centre

Join in all the games, crafts, day trips and assist the staff and other volunteers at the Day Centre. Share your interests with the clients, take clients for walks or just provide someone for clients to talk to.

The Lakes Hostel

This is a low level care facility and as such the residents are more independent. You may wish to assist the Diversional Therapist with the set activity program or you can take residents for a walk, garden, read, listen or just talk and spend time with older people.

Kowree Nursing Home

This is a high care facility and as such the residents are more dependent on staff for their daily needs. Activities with residents may include, reading, wheelchair walks, assistance with the Diversional Therapy activity program or just sitting and talking.

Drivers

Volunteer drivers allow residents and clients to attend appointments and social functions.

Other

Depending on the skills of the individual there may be other areas that you feel you may wish to volunteer for. These can be discussed with the Volunteer Coordinator.
